White County Residents are reminded to get building permits for repairs to damaged structures.

Residents of White County are reminded that with the recent Flooding, many structures in the community may have experienced damage. Repairs and/or reconstruction activities to the structures damaged due to the flooding that are located in the floodplain will require a local building permit from the Building and Planning office as required by White County zoning and building code ordinances. Failure to obtain the necessary permits can result in fines up to \$300 per day of violation. In addition, depending on a property's location, a permit may also be required from the Indiana Department of Natural Resources prior to the start of any reconstruction activity.
